

HB 160: Cooper's Law

This bill has passed out of Committee

This bill would allow parents to modify/adjust their property or erect structures on their property for their children for disability needs and therapeutic purposes contrary to a Home Owners Association's by laws/rules. This bill is known as Cooper's Law due to a family in Lexington whose son Cooper who suffers from cerebral palsy was told he could not have his therapeutic play house. They are being fined by the HOA.
