There is a Senate Bill for Industrial Hemp ([SB 61](#)), but there is not a House Bill. Comer intends to approach this from all angles, so he is going to the Capitol this **WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 11TH, 2012** to speak to the House Agricultural Committee about getting Industrial Hemp Legislation introduced and passed. Next week he will be supporting Industrial Hemp in the Senate and we will send an alert about that at a more appropriate time. For now this is the action you need to take.
