

# SB 22: 30 Day Legislative Sessions

The odd year legislative sessions are 30 days the even year sessions in which they determine the budget is 60 Days. SB 22 would limit the even year sessions to 30 days, thus forcing the legislature to focus solely on their constitutional duty of *balancing the budget* instead of passing laws that are either stupid, useless, feel good, pad pockets, wastes money (shorter session saves money too), or restricts our freedoms and violates the Kentucky Constitution.
