

# Dissolve Area Planning Commissions

## [Support SB 62](#)

This bill passed the Senate and has made it to the House State Government Committee

Local Area Planning Commissions are entities the government has allowed to be created generally for more than one county area under the guise of getting rid of bureaucracy. However, adding another layer of government is not less bureaucracy. What's worse is they can have taxing authority per KRS 146.660. What this bill proposes to do is lower the percentage of those signatures needed to dissolve a one from 25% of those who voted in the last presidential election to 10%. One county (Kenton) has been dealing with this entity, when it actually appears per the statute that it should be multiple counties.
